

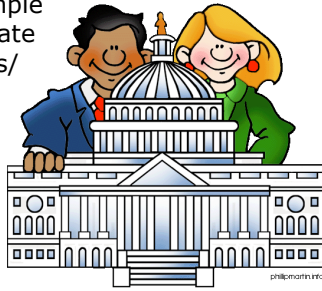
CITY HALL

The City Hall Observer program was created by the Cleveland Area Board of REALTORS to ensure that new legislation does not negatively affect the real estate industry or private property owners' rights.

City Hall Observers are the eyes and ears for the real estate industry. CHOs keep the Government Affairs Committee informed of "hot" issues. The role of City Hall Observer is an informative role only and not one of advocacy.

CHOs are asked to submit simple forms to report any real estate activity or meeting agendas/minutes to the CABOR staff. It is as simple as that!
